Maintenance Schedule of Monthly Services Performed
(Work should follow with client specific requests)

January - Weekly Service Provided

Prune crape-myrtles, pampas grass, and liriop. "Dead head" pansies. Round one of fertilization program. Cut and maintain property as needed. Pine straw recommended. Complete any heavy tree trimming.

February - Weekly Service Provided

Prune crape-myrtles, pampas grass, and liriop. "Dead head" pansies. Round one or two of fertilization program. Cut and Maintain property when needed.

March - Weekly Service Provided

Cut and maintain lawn as needed. Round two of fertilization program. Heavy pruning and trimming of bushes.

April - Weekly Service Provided

Scalp Bermuda followed by aeration and sand, if desired. Round three of fertilization program. Maintain property as needed. Fescue will begin to grow. Spring flowers installed.

May - Weekly Service Provided

Maintain property. Round three of fertilization program. Spring flowers installed.

June - Weekly Service Provided

Maintain property. Round three and four fertilization program.

July - Weekly Service Provided

Maintain property. Round four and five of fertilization program. Second application of pine straw recommended.

August - Weekly Service Provided

Maintain property. Round five of fertilization program.

September - Weekly Service Provided

Maintain property. End of month start aeration of over-seeding of fescue. Fall flowers installed.

October - Weekly Service Provided

Maintain property and blow leaves. Leaves from the front and sides of property will be removed. Leaves from parking lot will be removed. Leaves in back of building will be blown into existing tree areas. Aeration and over-seeding of fescue. Round six of fertilization program. Fall flowers installed.

November - Weekly Service Provided

Maintain property and blow leaves. Round six and seven of fertilization program.

December - Weekly Service Provided

Maintain property and blow leaves. Round seven of fertilization program if needed. Prune pampas grass, and liriop. "Dead head" pansies. Can begin cut-back of overgrown trees.
